## Introduction

Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital and Research Centre was established in 1995 under the aegis of New Kashmir Educational Society registered under the Jammu & Kashmir Societies, Registration Act. The academic activities were started in 1995-96. The Institute is affiliated to the University of Kashmir, Hazratbal, Srinagar and follows the curriculum prescribed by National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM).

The Institute offers Under Graduate course in Bachelor of Unani Medicine and Surgery (BUMS). The Institute is being developed as a Model Institute for teaching, training, research and patient care in Unani System of Medicine. The institute is spread over 4.5 acres of land and consists of 60 bed Hospital, Academic Block, Administrative Block, Library, Indoor Games Hall, Canteen, Pharmacy Unit, Drug Museum Cum Herbarium, Herbal Garden, and various other Laboratories attached to Hospital and Academic Block.

## Management

## Admissions

The selection for BUMS Course is made through National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (NEET). The NEET is National level Undergraduate Medical Entrance exam, conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA), for selection of candidates to various Medical Courses including BUMS Course. Once the examination is conducted, a list of qualified candidates in order of All India Rank based on the score obtained in the examination is prepared by NTA and result is declared. A copy of the result is given to the Directorate General of Health Services (Medical Education Cell), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India to provide the same to the admitting authorities.

In case of J&K State, the admitting authority is J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examination (BOPEE) which is also the state designated authority for counseling. The BOPEE thereafter short list the qualified candidates (keeping in view the ratio of seats available and the number of qualified candidates). The short-listing is followed by invitation of applications for counseling. On the basis of counseling and marks / merit obtained in the NEET (All India Rank), a selection list of candidates, to be admitted in the College under State Government quota, is drawn by the BOPEE and forwarded to the College for their admission to BUMS Course, in a given academic session.

For the academic year 2023-24, the UT authority for counseling has not followed the Counseling schedule as prescribed by the NCISM. Non- observance of the Counseling schedule coupled with late and a little reduction in the percentile by NCISM resulted into the loss of almost 50% of seats to this and other Unani College in the UT of J&K. The need for effective implementation of counseling scheduled at all India level and reduction in percentile before starting of Counseling has been severely felt so that the loss of seats may be minimized.

## **Library**

Access to information is a vital key in developing the individuals potentiality. The College has provided a Central Library consisting more than 10,000 books and adequate number of journals. All the latest editions of books both for reference and text are available in this library. It also subscribes to various newspaper and periodicals for the information and update of their knowledge. The journals of both National and International, related to all Medical subjects are also subscribed. The library is spread over 130 sq.mtrs. and has the seating capacity of 50 students in its reading sections.

## **Departmental Libraries**

The libraries in the faculties / departments offer more specialized collections of books, Journals and periodicals for particular subject, which are issued under proper issue registers maintained in the Central Library.

## **Hostel**

Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital & Research Centre (KTCHRC) has coordinated with Madr-e-Meharban Women's Hostels, Miskeen Bagh Khanyar, Srinagar, with a view to facilitate the female students who wish to avail the hostel accommodation. College is also persuading and coordinating with Hostels for facilitating the availability of accommodation for boys. The hostels have limited seats and it is offered by the Hostel Authorities on first come first served basis on depositing of the required hostel fee.

## **Auditorium**

A well furnished auditorium with state of the art audio, video facilities and seating capacity of 300 students is being developed for conduct of various functions to facilitate student's activities. The auditorium facilities are utilized during Seminars, Symposia, Conferences, EC Activities, Guest Lecturers, fresher's party, Convocation Programme, farewell functions and other cultural functions, etc.

## **Herbal Garden**



Herbal Garden of the college is situated at the rear end of the college campus. Area of Herbal garden is 2500 sq. mtrs. having required number of species and plants which include medicinal herbs, shrubs, trees and climbers. Herbal garden is equipped with appropriate water source, tools and other materials. The facility of green house is being provided for better propagation and preservation of medicinal plants/herbs. The herbal garden is maintained by the skilled garden workers. Herbal Garden facilitates the academic and research need of the institute. The main objective is to facilitate the training and teaching of medicinal plants by way of identification and demonstration of the medicinal plants.

### **Canteen**

A canteen is functioning within the premises of the Institute to serve hygienically prepared food to the staff and students. It is open from morning up to the time the students/staff are in the premises of the Institute. A delicious, hygienic and wholesome food is provided catering to the needs of various students, staffs and faculty.

### **Transport**

The Institute provides transport services regularly between campus and the city. Institute buses are available to the students and faculty / staff members for commuting from various points in the city to the Institute.

### **Sports**

The Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital & Research Centre (KTCHRC) has sufficient dedicated space with latest equipments and instruments for indoor and outdoor games, e.g., Table Tennis, Badminton, Chess, Football, Volleyball and cricket. The KTCHRC has set up a Sports Club which aims to help students to achieve excellence by re-energizing them through regular sports events throughout the year. It encourages active participation of students along through team-work and provides a platform to display and develop their individual sporting skills.

### **Classrooms**

The College has dust free, well furnished adequate classrooms with state of the art infrastructure for direct teaching-learning process, presentations and discussions etc.

The classrooms on different floors are easily accessible, spacious, safe reasonably comfortable and cognitively stimulating, besides well-lit in order for students to read, write and follow what their teacher is saying. All the classrooms / lecture theaters are been shared by all the departments in a programmed manner.

## **Laboratories**

The necessary lab facilities are available for the academic accomplishment of the students. The laboratories are well equipped with modern manikins, simulation and stainless work station with water and sinks. Labs like Munafe-ul-Aza (Physiology), pharmacognosy, Pharmacy, Mahiyatul Amraz (Pathology) in the College gives ample opportunity for the students to carry experimental practical's.

## **Museums**

The Museum in a Medical College is treasures of riches that need to be safeguarded for the reference of the future doctors. The specimens in the museums provide immensely useful information for the students. The College lays enough stress on upgrading the specimen collection in the museums regularly. A separate Museum for Tashreeh-ul-Badan (Anatomy), Ilmul Advia (Pharmacology), Ilmul Saidal (Pharmacy), Tahafuzi wa Samaji Tib (SPM), Jarahat (Surgery), Ain Uzn Anf Halaq Wa Asnan (ENT & Optho), Niswan-wa-Qabalat (Gyane & Obstetrics) and Ilmul Atfal (Pediatrics) are housed in the respective departments along with tutorial rooms with good collection of specimens, embryological models and translight exhibits.

## **Internal Quality Assurance Cell**

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is conceived as a mechanism to build and ensure a quality culture at the College level. The IQAC is meant for planning, guiding and monitoring Quality Assurance (QA) and Quality Enhancement (QE) activities of the College. ### **Research and Innovation Cell**

As per the instructions conveyed by the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, a “Research and Innovation Cell” has been constituted in the College with the objective of organizing Capacity Building Programmes on Entrepreneurship Development, given the huge scope for Innovations in Indian System of Medicine. A senior faculty member has been nominated as Coordinator of the given Cell, who has been accepted and selected by the NCISM for the Capacity Building Programme “Entrepreneurship Development”

### **Anti-Ragging Policy**

The College is aware of the fact that prevention and prohibition of ragging in institutions imparting higher education in the country is a great concern of all authorities including the law enforcing agencies. Regulations have been framed by various apex bodies of higher education in the country in order to root out ragging in all its forms in the universities and its affiliated colleges in the country by prohibiting it by enacting law too. In this context, the Report submitted by the Raghavan Committee constituted by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in SLP No. 24295/2006 is relevant. Hon’ble Supreme Court of India accepted the various recommendations made by the Raghavan Committee and made it mandatory for the concerned to implement the following recommendations.

1. The punishment to be meted out has to be exemplary and justifiably harsh to act as a deterrent against recurrence of such incidents.
2. Every single incident of ragging where the victim or his parent/guardian or the Head of Institution is not satisfied with the institutional arrangement for action, a First Information Report must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities. Any failure on the part of the institutional authority or negligence or deliberate delay in lodging the FIR with the local police shall be construed to be an act of culpable negligence on the part of the authorities by the Courts. All efforts should be made to ensure that cases involving ragging are taken up on priority basis to send the correct message that ragging is not only to be discouraged but also to be dealt with sternness.

Hence, it is emphasized that ragging of and among students of this College in any form at any place will not be tolerated and it is banned.

### **Measures for prohibition and prevention of Ragging in the College**

The College is having an Anti Ragging Committee headed by the head of the College. If the committee finds that prima facie there is a case of ragging on the Complaint it received, the committee will take immediate action including the filing of FIR with the local police depending on the seriousness of the case.

The college has also constituted an anti-ragging squad for maintaining vigil, oversight and patrolling functions so as to remain mobile, alert and active at all times. It is the duty of the anti-ragging squad to be called upon to make surprise raids at any places vulnerable to incidents of, and having the potential of, ragging and is empowered to inspect such places. It is also the duty of the anti-ragging squad to conduct an on-the-spot enquiry into any incident of ragging referred to it by the Head of the Institution or any member of the faculty or any member of the staff or any student or any parent or guardian or any employee of a service provider or by any other person, as the case may be; and the enquiry report along with recommendation shall be submitted to the anti-ragging committee for action under relevant provision of the anti-ragging regulations.

Any student of Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital & Research Centre found indulging and / or abetting any form of ragging shall be meted out with exemplary and justifiably harsh punishment including debarring such students from taking admissions in any institutions of higher learning in the country.

### **Collegiate Students Grievance Redressal Committee**

The objective of the Collegiate Students Grievance Redressal Committee is to develop a responsible and positive attitude among students in order to maintain a harmonious educational atmosphere in Kashmir Tibbia College Campus.

College Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted for the redressal of the problems reported by the students with the following objectives:

- i. Upholding the dignity of the Institution by ensuring strife free atmosphere in the Institute through promoting cordial student-student relationship and student teacher relationship etc.
- ii. To support, those students who have been deprived of the services for which he/she is entitled.
- iii. To make teaching and supporting staff responsive, accountable, courteous in dealing with the students
- iv. To ensure effective solution to the student grievances with an impartial and fair approach
- v. Encouraging the students to express their grievance/problems freely and frankly without any fear of being victimized
- vi. Advising the students to respect the right of dignity of one another and show restraint and patience whenever any occasion arises.
- vii. Advising the students to refrain from inciting students against other students or teachers and institute Administration
- viii. To ensure effective solution to the students grievances with an impartial and fair approach.

Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital & Research Centre ensures a student-friendly ambience. The constitution of the College Grievance Redressal Committee is a part of our incessant effort to create a conducive atmosphere. This Committee, consisting of trained and experienced faculty, deals with non-academic grievances, while mentors sort out academic matters. Grievances can be posted in the suggestion boxes, which are opened every week.

## **Hospital Wing**

The hospital has 7 OPD's wing and 60 beds IPD having separate wards for male and female patients. It possesses good infrastructure and skillful staff extending their services to the patients. Registration fee is kept at Rs. 10/= only. All medical investigations are done on subsidized rates with free Medicine. The treatment is totally based on Unani Medicine. However, the hospital is facilitated with latest diagnostic tools

which help in diagnosis and research. The following OPDs and IPDs are functional in the hospital.

- b) Jarahat including Ain, Uzn, Anaf, Halaq wa Asnan (Surgery including Eye, ENT and Dentistry).

- e) Amraze Jild wa Tazeeniyat (Skin Diseases and Cosmetology).
- f) Tahaffuzi wa Samaji Tib (Community Medicine).
- g) Fever OPD

### 2. IPDs

- a) Moalajat including Ilaj Bit Tadbeer and Amraze Jild wa Tazeeniy.
- b) Jarahat including Ain, Uzn, Anaf, Halaq.
- c) Qabalat wa Amraze Niswan.
- d) Amraze Atfal.

## Pharmacy

A Pharmacy is housed in the hospital wing of the college in order to provide prepared and crude medicine to the OPD and IPD patients. Besides that a well equipped pharmacy unit is engaged in processing and preparing several formulations in different dosage forms like Safoof, Majoon, Sharbat, Arq, Roghan, Marham, Khamira etc to cater the needs of IPD and OPD patients like. The pharmacy unit is well equipped for this purpose.

## Illaj Bit Tadbeer (Regimental Therapy) Unit

Illaj Bit Tadbeer (Regimental Therapy) unit comprises of diverse treatment modalities based on the principles of modification in Asbab-e-Sitta Zarooriya (Six essential factors). This unit is functioning in full swing. Separate room for Physiotherapy has been kept in place.

Following regimens are operational for the treatment of a wide variety of diseases:

- a. Dalk (Massage)
- b. Hijamat (Cupping)
- c. Irsale Alaq (Leeching)
- d. Takmeed bukhari (Steam bath)
- e. Nutool (Irrigation)
- f. Pashoya (Foot bath)
- g. Zimad (Liniment)
- h. ammam( Turkish Bath)

The section of physiotherapy comprises of following treatment facilities:

- a. Short wave diathermy
- b. Ultrasound therapy unit
- c. Transcutaneous electrical nerve stimulator
- d. Unit Interferential Therapy Unit
- e. Nerve muscle electrical stimulator unit
- f. Long wave diathermy Intermittent traction unit Cervical/ Pelvic
- g. Hydro Collator moist heat therapy
- h. Cryotherapy (Hot/Cold gel pack)
- i. Therapeutic paraffin wax therapy
- j. Specific instruments for the exercise of upper and lower limbs

The above mentioned Regimenal and Physiotherapy facilities are very useful in the treatment of the diseases like Hypertension, Diabetes, Obesity, various Neurological disorders like Stroke, Cerebral Palsy, Neuropathies, Spinal Injury, Neuromuscular Disorders, Muscular Dystrophy, various types of Headaches, Motor Neuron Diseases, Degenerative Joint Disorders, Low Backache, Sciatica, Ski Diseases, Varicose Veins, Non-healing Ulcers, Chronic painful conditions, Sports injuries, Post Traumatic Rehabilitation, Post Operative Rehabilitation, Deformity Management etc.

## **Operation Theater**

Out of the services provided by the Hospital, a high priority is given for the facilities in the OT, which has been equipped with modern and sophisticated machinery & equipment, to provide an efficient and highly reliable service at concessionary rates,



## **Labour Room**

The Labour Room has been equipped with all necessary equipments and supplies that the laboring patient may require to include, Delivery beds, Oxygen and air supply, Crash cot with a range of medications, multiparameter Patient monitors, CTG for babies, all necessary Instruments & Trays and supplies, Baby warmers, cut and coag etc.

## **Radiology and Sonography**

A latest electrocardiograph (ECG) and X-Ray machine is operated by experienced ECG and X-Ray Technicians. Both the units are operational under the expert guidance of Radiologist and Radio-technician. An Ultrasound Unit is also functioning and doing routine scans.

## **Clinical Laboratory**

Clinical Laboratory is attached with the hospital to carry out routine pathological, biochemical and microscopical tests under the expert guidance of experienced technicians. It is equipped with latest instruments. The laboratory is operational on all the working days, where most of the Bio-chemical, Hematological tests, Hormonal assays and many other tests are done. The specimens are processed by qualified technicians and reported by authorized staff. A strict quality control is maintained. good rebate is given to the OPD & IPD patients and senior Citizens attending OPD of the hospital on all medical investigations.

This laboratory is one of the few that serves patients of a tertiary care medical college hospital.

## **Vaccination Unit**

KTCHRC associated Hospital Services provides routine immunization for infants and children. Immunizations are free of charge for infants and children.

## **Covid-19 - Room**

A Separate Covid-19 room has been established to deal with patients of Covid-19. The room is equipped with all necessary Gadgets, PPE Kits, Covid-19 testing Kits and Immune Booster Medicines. Covid-19 testing is conducted and medicines distributed free of cost.

## **Dental Section**

A fully equipped dental section with qualified full time dental surgeon is working round the clock in the Hospital and attracts good patient profile. The section is regularly holding dental check-up camps in the nearby schools and disseminate education about dental health care and hygiene.

## Extra Curricular Activities

Kashmir Tibbia College, Hospital and Research Centre promotes various extra-curricular and activities for the development of students, teachers and other staff. 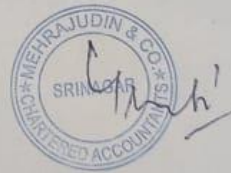
